For those that missed the notification, SB129 (if passed) will require offenders to pay 50 cents per visit for all non-emergency medical examinations or treatment. SB129 has passed the House and is now before the Senate. Therefore, we have one last opportunity to present opposition to SB129 before it is enacted and becomes law. (Sponsors listed below) Remember Health Care for offenders is required by Missouri Statute 217.230, and the 8th and 14th Amendments of the U.S. Constitution further establish this right.
