


OUR RIGHTS

The Black Panther rights as an actual political party are protected by the compilation of selected civil rights laws as amended through the 105th Congress, first session of the Civil Rights Commission Act of 1983. Anyone who is not in compliance with the following fundamental simplicities of these Civil Right Acts is placing our party continuation at risk. They are:

- (1.) Civil Rights Act of 1957, 1960, 1964
- (2.) Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972.
- (3.) Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
- (4.) Title III of the Age Discrimination Act of 1975.
- (5.) Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987.
- (6.) Civil Rights Act of 1968.
- (7.) Voting Rights Act of 1965.
- (8.) Civil Rights of Institutional Persons Act of 1991.
- (9.) Civil Rights Act of 1991.
- (10.) Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

Prisoner Voting Rights**

Black Panther Ministers do not preach hate. We preach solutions to oppression and reform to our oppressors. No matter how many lies our oppressors disseminate about our communities, statistics don't lie.

Our most powerful weapon in the Black Panther arsenal is our ability to use rational thought as servants of the people.

Original Party Black Panthers

Federal law prohibits discrimination in voting practices on the basis of race, color, previous condition of servitude, sex disability, being a member of a language minority, or age if you are 18 years of age or older. If you are convicted of a felony in North Carolina you temporarily lose citizenship including your right to vote. Any prior registration you had before your felony conviction is cancelled by the County Board of Elections with no action on your part. ANY ATTEMPT TO REGISTER TO VOTE WHILE YOU ARE AN ACTIVE FELON IS A FELONY, although felons can't vote in North Carolina. Prisoners can support any candidate without the prison administrations interference. No matter if it is for the "Primary Elections" or "General Elections". Sections 11(b.) Voting Rights Act of 1965 States: No person, whether acting under color of law or otherwise, shall intimidate, threaten, or coerce, or attempt to intimidate, threaten, or coerce any person for voting or attempting to vote, or intimidate, threaten, or coerce, or attempt to intimidate, threaten, or coerce any person aiding any person to vote or attempt to vote, or intimidate, threaten, or coerce any person for exercising any powers or duties under section 3(a) 6, 8, 9, 10, or 12(e).
