Of what purpose is a grievance policy where all concerns are summarily dismissed in favor of facility administration? The same persons who implement policy, sit in judgement of prisoners opposition to said policy. This is akin to taking your wife to court, and finding your mother in law is the judge. Any legitimate, effective procedure in which prisoners may hope to obtain judicial re-dress must be framed in the validity of impartiality; for all persons concerned, a process other than that which is "not an official policy, for informational purposes only" is essential to the penological interest. Decisions by administration here are the greatest proof of a preponderance of impartiality, and that a new process is needed to actually address the concerns of prisoners and staff members within these walls.
