

Consolidation; How To Cut Administrative Cost While Maximizing Programs

"Amendment 1 [1791]

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances."

"We The People" must Remember that according to the 14th. Amendment, Section 1.:

"Amendment XIV [1868]

Section 1. All persons born or naturalized in the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States and of the State wherein they reside. No State shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of citizens of the United States; nor shall any State deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws."

"We The People" must Remember that according to the 15th. Amendment, Section 1..

"Amendment XV [1870]

Section 1. The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude."

"We The People" must Remember that in the 19th. Amendment, Section 1.;

"Amendment XIX [1920]

Section 1. The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex."

"We The People" must Remember that in the 26th. Amendment, Section 1.;

"Amendment XXVI [1971]

Section 1. The right of citizens of the United States, who are eighteen years of age or older, to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of age."

"We the People" must Remember what our Forefathers fought and died for; which is the freedom of religion, and the Freedom to provide for our Children and Families; with minimum or no interference from our Government, etc.. "We The People" must Remember that the right to vote, and have control over our Families, and our Nation's policies; is every Citizen's Moral, Ethical, Spiritual, and Humane Right, Responsibility, and Duty to God, Country, and Self.

Conclusion
