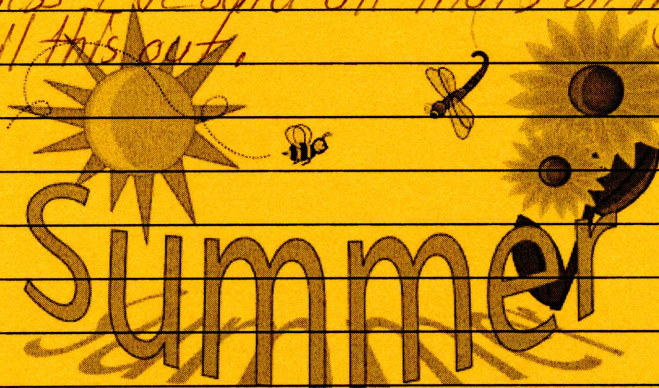
To be honest, I think I'll also receive the 12 Weeks since my RVR happened before the Deadline.
