To Whom It May Concern,

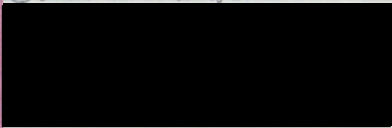
The following is about my personal experience of incarceration during the pandemic. Also about incarceration.

First off, during COVID-19, I and others continuously get locked down due to some inmate(s) catching the virus, we all would be locked down 2 weeks and re-evaluate. Not only does the COVID-19 causes lockdowns, there's an emergency ~~within~~ within the institution, we experience this more than the virus. Lately, we've been doing tier by tier, meaning on all odd days, top tier is out in the morning from 7am - 10am. Then from 5pm to 8:45pm. Meanwhile, bottom tier is out only from 10am to 3:30pm. On even days, bottom tier is out in the morning from 7am to 10am, then again at 5pm to 8:45pm. Top tier being out only from 10am to 3:30pm. This schedule is still in affect to this very day.

Also, the politics here are high. I get harassed almost everyday because of why I'm here. I'm not even allowed to grudge because I may have disease of some sort. I get discriminated and won't even get my job that I love so much back because of "short time". Well, per policy here, I'm allowed to get my job back if never got an incident report (which I never got). I was in SHU for 3 1/2 days and I'm out of a job with a snap! Also, sex offenders are NOT allowed to sit at my tables what-so-ever, we've had to eat in our cells because of politics going on. We also do NOT get to watch any TV. We sometimes get bullied and myself and others don't always stand up for ourselves because of not wanting to get injured. All this occurs every week and nothing is being done about it. Other than that, that's all I have.
