During this pandemic the above mentioned methods have increased significantly; becoming harsher on the inmate population. For example: Contact visits ceased due to the coronavirus. Congress enacted the Cores Act of 2020 giving the Criminal Justice System funds to help families keep in contact with their incarcerated loved ones. The funds are to ensure skype capability for visiting and 500 phone minutes a month to communicate properly with family and friends. The Warden (Scott Finley) knowing now more then ever how important communication is during todays hardships. Mr Finley is having communication devices turned off for reasons as simple as a single bed not made properly. This is one example of the mental abuse an inmate is subjected to. Furthermore, Courts have already found and adopted that todays prison conditions could not of been foreseen at the time of sentencing and warrant time reductions of sentences. My question is where is the compassion? Lives are being taken by a volatile force of nature and the Wardens pet peeve is an unmade 3 inch mat.

Because this institution still does not have skype or any of the things that help families stay together, you can get a visit for one hour (depending on his mood) once a month. No contact, behind a shower curtain. Now, imagine your friends or relatives driving from Maine or some distant state to see you. Driving 10 hours to be molested by some man or woman correctional officer to see you for approximately 60 minutes. God forbid the justice system does what congress enacted in the First Step Act and allow inmates to be sent close to home.

Violence erupting among inmates is on the rise between phones and access to e-mail. 120 inmates three phones so 40 inmates per phone. Lets not forget your mandatory work detail. The inmates at this institution can count themselves fortunate if they can call someone once a day. Safety and Security go hand and hand when it comes to prison program statements. However, this seems to be the desired effect to keep the vast majority focused on each other rather than the cause. County, State, and some Federal Prisons issue tablets that allow visiting, phone calls, and even commissary ordering eliminating the constant feuding and politics of Covid-19 Abuse.

June 12th 2021 I lost my baby brother. Outside the purview of my current incarceration My regret is that during this pandemic, I wasn't able to communicate with him on a regular basis. His death weighs heavy on ^{my} shoulders. There are so many others who are suffering just like me. To deprive someone of freedom for breaking the law is one thing, but to attempt to remove what is left of their humanity, family, and ethics to transform a man or woman into a compliant sycophant so you can satify your egotism is outright William Lynch indoctrination strategies.
