

Health Care:-

In October 2019 I was transferred to (OCCC) Old Colony Correctional Center. I started to get ill in November 2019. (certain foods caused me to have intestinal problems), Foods that never caused me problems before. This continued for over a year, progressively getting worse, and leading to me bleeding. I put sick slips in and some were ignored while others were responded to "It could be Hemroids".

In late Feb. 2021 I went to the State Hospital and received a diagnosis of UC. (Ulcerative Colitis), as well as Anemia. During this ordeal I have gone from 170 pounds to a sickly 135 pounds.

Boston's Area hospital tried various medications with no luck, I was not going to allow a colostomy bag to be installed so they tried a bio-logic medication called (Infleximab) it's like Humira. It's an infusion I get every 8 weeks. I know this type of medical service would not pass on the streets, just because we are incarcerated does not mean we should get sub-par health care.
