Clearly there is an on going problem, 3 looking at the death toll, "lock downs" are not the solution. When is the Federal Bureau of Prisons going to realize that locking a man behind a door for extended periods of time only exacerbates the situation? Confining a man/men to a cell creates problems 3 triggers mental health issues. This is a fact.
