

Discrimination for the Innocent Inmates

Who is the real voice of the innocent inmates? I can tell you, who its not, The Prison DOC, The Governor, Lt Governor's office, Centumen Ministros and the PA Innocent Project, or any Prison Legal Prison Project Groups. Why?

It seems to be, they are only interested in helping guilty inmates, to have a more comfortable life and give out incentives to keep them happy as clams, while the innocent inmates struggle. There is a solution, claims the Prison DOC, "ADMIT GUILT".

They you can be part of the prison population that enjoys incentives.

- 1) get paroled, and get transitional help
- 2) get schooling and enjoy education programs to help you re-enter into society like all the others.
- 3) re-entry and a lot of transitional housing and job opportunities
- 4) mental help, and group help to get over the trauma in your childhood that caused you to be a felon, and lead a life of being a criminal.

Now, here's the problems of innocent inmates claiming to be guilty

1) you lied, somewhere along the line. your a liar, you lied in court, you lied in any Appeal you filed, will parole believe you? Now that you got a "new" story of what really happened, "No!"

2) Kiss commutation away, your a liar, and now you got 2 whole different stories, maybe more, for why you came to jail, then the Lt Governor's office will ask you if they can "pretty up" the "new story". So the board will give you the thumbs up, which they want, you lied for nothing

3) Do you even remember what the truth is? Because now your brain washed into thinking, your guilty, you got a new scripted "story" to tell, which is your new truth and memories, because no one will believe you, and you got a new bright idea to fight back, after you get paroled, for real justice, because its your only chance to get out of prison.

I have questions for the group of organizations set up to "help" innocent inmates re-enter into society.

1) They have all these incentives and advantages given to the guilty inmates in prison, mostly men and long termers, yet no incentives or help for the innocent inmates. What can you do to change that?

2) Most material help in prison libraries are out dated, agencies are closed or moved, with no forwarding information available. Is there a way to send prisons, resources or information on a CD disc, or zip drive, to load on the library desktops, as used to update and access luxury programs, or through email documents for librarians to load in computers, as they do to research or update book queries, or business and agency addresses, so updated resources can be located sooner, rather than later or too late to use for innocent inmates to receive direction and assistance needed.

3) As we know, innocent inmates will not be paroled, unless they plead "guilty" to the fake charges and make up a "story" to convince parole. They are remorseful and regret the "events" that didn't occur, and in the

future, they will not do what they didn't do, and lead a better life.

A lot of inmates, "go along" with this idea to get out of jail, and rather face society and all the restrictions placed upon them, then to fight back against a corrupt court system. The question remains, when the truth finally comes out, and it usually does, eventually there will be perjury, whether, in court, at parole hearings (after they lied to parole) through statements and mandatory programs, shouldnt someone advise these inmates that what happens during programs and parole hearings, can affect future fights for the innocence during appeals, while on parole. Are they lying to police, lying to program directors, parole hearings or in Appeals? will be the question

4) Several years ago. Brandon Flood visited SCE Muncy, assuming everyone was guilty of their crimes, because he was, when several inmates stood up and asked what is he going to do about the innocent inmates, since he was offering all these "incentives" to the guilty inmates, (pardons, clemency, and commutations)

He had nothing to say, later he sent a message of a "pardon" application "coming soon for innocent inmates" it never happened, and he continued to promote parole for inmates and commutations, along with his "panel of experts".

I wrote to the Lt Governor's Office, Governor's Office, the Prison Projects, the PA Innocence Projects and the Superintendent of SCE Muncy, and also to Camp Hill DOC. Nobody cares, or will help, I now ask, who is the real voice of the innocent inmates? I come with only one solution, sue your accuser, as in Finn v Bilens, Civil No. 3:19-CV-1905
October 5, 2020. Make the fake accusers feel the heat, for ruining peoples

reputations and all the mental anguish we go through every day
in our fight for real justice.
