Im not exactly sure how to go about writing to you about this prison time here in Aliceville AL. I've done prison time before but nothing like this. I am lockdown for 22 hrs a day with very little time to communicate with the outside world. I understand that the prisons have to take precautions, but some of the conditions and living is not acceptable to me. Of course as an inmate I HAVE to accommodate and make due with what's available. The prison quarantine is entering and leaving the prison. I've been tested 3 times, today again Im still negative. There's no work here at the moment and very little programs.

I was told to pack up my things yesterday, not advised ahead of time by any staff member about where Im going. I still don't know.

The staff are very unprofessional and lack any communication skills, and dont anyone dare push the emergency call button, ONLY if myself or my bunkie are dying or dead. I've already had 2 medical issues where I ended up being taken to the hospital due to medical negligence. Being able to get anything done about the unprofessionalism by complaints or getting my records is frustration because I get ignore or no response through email or cop-outs.

I've only been here since July 23. 20 and still on lockdown as if Im a maximum violent criminal, when Im on low status and should be recieving re-entry programs or working. Thank you for hearing me out. Stay Blessed.
