

Incorrect Corrections

The way people go about correcting errant behavior is in and of itself errant behavior. If the Person or "Animal" is not aware of what it has actually done wrong then your corrective measures will be taken wrong and may teach the wrong message. If physical punishment it may also be seen as abuse. Sadly much of the punishments are extreme and are abuse. Corrections are not made by physical punishment and are all actually mental and psychological views and opinions that lead to the errant behavior. It is these errant ideals that must be fixed carefully and carefully. Punishments only lead to harm and confusion which may and often do lead to a re-enforcement of the original errant ideals and behaviors and often create new ones. The Current method of corrections by punishment is completely backwards and is all wrong and the system grossly profits off the abuses and tortures as well as pain and suffering it causes all those it punishes whilst falsely claiming to "correct".

I personally know a man of whom was once a teacher of mine. He had a little shitzu dog... a puppy and it needed to be house broke. Listen to that term "House Broke." If one would really contemplate the true meaning of that term you'd see the truth of how **WRONG** this process is and how it is abuse. Now this man when he would find Urin or feces on the floor would

snatch up the dog, rub its nose and face in it, spank the dog with his hand... then throw it off the front porch outside. Now this is a tiny creature and you can easily do serious harm and damage just by tickling or scratching their belly not realizing it is too hard and your pushing in way hard on finger points. So you can imagine picking up a 0 to 3 month old baby and slapping the crap out of it then throwing it outside on the ground. This is exactly what this man had done. He repeated this behavior also when he'd catch the dog in the act. Dogs grow to full maturity much faster than humans and by 6 months it is indeed grown but did NOT learn what the man wanted it to BUT the man did succeed in "Breaking" his \$200 dog. Just NOT how he wanted.

At 6 months of age the dog would pee or poop on the floors of the house and then rub its own face in it and roll in it and would run outside yelping and jump off the porch. If the door is shut the dog would go nuts to get the door open to run yelping and jump off the porch... It would then go roll in the dirt to clean itself off. Worse is his own dog would bite him and most others... all but his wife. If you raised your voice or even acted aggressive the dog would freak out. Shortly after the first year the man and his wife's baby was bitten by the dog. He put his damaged dog down... The sad

truth is his dog was derranged and it was his punishment and house breaking of the dog that truly broke his dog. He paid an additional \$400 to have his dog euthenized... (a fancy way to say "murdered").

The man did realize his mistake far too late. In this he did get another dog. He applied a very different method to this dog and is a similar method he used on his two daughters and son. He spent a LOT of time with the puppy talking to it, playing and petting. When the dog was doing something he didn't like he'd give a stern "NO!" and would turn the dog away from what it was doing. If it used the floor as a place to pee or poo, he'd point at it and give a stern "No!" then take the mess to a certain place outside and drop it there then place the dog near and say "there" or "outside." If he'd catch the dog in the act he'd take it outside to the place he specified. It didn't take long of giving the dog love and treats for doing its business outside that when it had to go, it went to the door. When it come back it got a treat. Later a Pet Door was installed so the dog can go any time it needs and funny enough the dog will also go get its own treat after going. This 2nd dog of which was the same breed as the first went so much better and it wasn't because of the dog but him. He did not BREAK the 2nd dog but instead taught in and

corrected an undesired behavior into a funny desired one... It is funny because they sit a few milk bones on the shelf and the dog will only go get one after doing its business outside. Sadly, most won't see the humor in this but will find the bizzar behavior of the first dog funny because it learned the wrong thing and continued the unwanted behavior whilst developing several others that were worse. This man knows HE killed his dog.

How are his children? Far from perfect as perfect doesn't exist but they are highly respectful well mannered children. Yes they get excited and carried away. All he does is talk to them to explain what they did, why it was wrong and several alternatives of what they could have done then what he thinks they could have done. If he ever told any of them he was disappointed in them and their behavior he'd ~~break~~ ^{break} their hearts. He always respects that they have choices and advises them and offers advice. He will only be stern when it is necessary and has ~~never~~ ^{never} had to spank or ground any of them. He has temporarily suspended some priviledges but that's about it. All three of them are very strong minded with a strong sense of morals and none of them believe in segregation and imprisonment nor physical pain as punishments to be used.

Why did this teacher share his Dog story with his

students? Because of several reasons. 1st of all he is a Social Sciences, Civics and Humanities education. 2nd of all he was raised in this system and in following it made its mistakes. 3rd of all he REALIZED this mistake and 4th of all he wanted to break and end that horrible behavioral pattern of a "need" for punishment or retribution under the disguise of behavioral correction. 5th and final is that he realized the punishment and abuse and the murder of his dog was a reflection of a dark and twisted behavior taught to him by society and his own parents and legal system. He couldn't live with that and so corrected it.

I also personally know of two boys and two girls that had a rough upbringing and are a direct reflection of their abuses of the "corrections" they endured. One set is a Brother and Sister of one family, the other set is a Brother and Sister of another family. I went to grade school and high school with them. They endured nightmares and only one of them is still alive today. All four of these people as children were in and out of trouble all the time. They all have been in DHS care and were put in foster homes and Juvenile Detention and were all rescued from those systems multiple times by the Cherokee Nation Indian Affairs system because the white man system does not have jurisdiction NOR the right to take and detain Native children. So everyone failed these

children and I mean Everyone! It is on Society and the Community the failure of any child by the adults and people in it. All four of these children were being abused by their parents and they were neglected. They all four come to school stinking, dirty in ratty dirty clothes. It was not at all their fault.

The first boy and girl were small and very scrawny... zero fat. This was due to malnourishment. Both of them came to school showed nearly completely bald to control lice and fleas at their house... and themselves. Both of them would come to school with bruises. The boy had very violent outbursts and very serious issues with authority. Serious issues. If anyone would yell at him or try to command him he'd instantly burst back with yelling and screaming. He would make threats. He'd very quickly escalate to a fight especially with anyone he'd perceive as bigger than him or with authority. He was always acting out. One day he struck a teacher and he disappeared. Oklahoma DITS took him and placed him in foster care... He got into fights with the kids and the foster family and so was put into a detention center where staff abused him physically and he was raped by a couple of girls there and several boys. His parents got him back... the Indian system got him when soon this all happened again. This was his pre teens in grade school... All in

memory of this he disappeared in grade school about five times until finally as a young teen he stabbed his dad. He was then put in a house by himself and there aside from some struggles in school he was doing well until DHS caught wind of a minor living alone... He disappeared into DHS, stabbed and killed a boy in juvenile detention and was put in prison for murder at 15... He got into it with a gang member in Prison and was stabbed to death. He was only 20 years old.

The girl of this first set was very quiet most times and was quick to be upset and cry. When she would play she was loud and would so easily get carried away and overly excited and overly loud then would get into trouble and would have a break down / melt down. Everything to her was a crisis. She would slunk down and do all she could to keep herself hidden and not at all draw any attention to herself. She wanted so desperately to play and fit in but was so afraid of the attention or the contact. As a young teen she became hooked on meth and would sell anything including herself for meth. She'd been beat and raped many times. Today she's a sweet woman with her own children and is sober living with HIV and all forms of Hepatitis from needle sharing and sexual partners and abuse. It took a death sentence for her to see her behaviors and path and to change them... to treat her children with love and care and teach them by her own

mistakes abuses and punishment... how not to be and break the cycle.

The other brother sister pair... both of them are dead... The boy was very similar to the first boy but in high school he got caught up in the drug game and was shot dead in a drug deal gone bad. His sister ran away at 16 tired of the physical and sexual abuse from her parents. She hated them both. Her boyfriend would rape her and beat her and forced her into prostitution. She was beaten and killed by her false savior. Both of them were in and out of the system and were both in the oaks mission.

All four of these children were good people.

They were heavily teased and made fun of. They were told by so many how terrible and worthless they were when they really just needed a safe place and real friend. EVERYONE and every system failed them.

When each one of them were put into corrections they placed these kids all in danger where they were abused worse than at home. All of them were beaten, assaulted and sexually assaulted either in Detention Centers by Police or by other staff and other kids. Some were beaten or abused by foster families. This exacerbated their existing behaviors and they all became tied up in drugs in detention as a

copeing mechanism to get away. The "Correction" was done incorrectly and subjected them to cruse treatment and abuses as well as torture and crue acts against them to correct them being raised up poor, neglected and abused.

I don't think the intended lesson was to teach all of them to despise and hate authority and to feel like they are worthless and meaningless trash. To be so scared that they are afraid of everyone and all situations and distrust all people. They learned they have to always fight and everyone wants to hurt or use them. They feel violence is the only answer and they seek refuge and safety in all the wrong places because it is what they know. They all paid for it by abuse and torture of their bodies and that they have no right or control of themselves so to be so high and blitzed out of their mind so they are just shut down and dead inside and are not there is what they all learned. They paid for it with broken minds, broken bodies and their lives. Just like my teacher's olog and so many others all around the United States.

I myself and my own siblings have all been subject to this form of Corrections just like everyone else in the United States. Punishment of abuses and tortures with pains and sufferings of all forms. Usually punished with no clue of what it was we actually did wrong

and quite often punished for what someone else did. Even more confusing is being punished for what you didn't do. We've been slapped, spanked, beat, emotionally and mentally goulded, imprisoned by segregation (grounded), had priviledges and things taken from us... I was once bound by ropes to a chair forced to read... We were all sexually abused by various peoples. The three of us raised and took care of eachother as best we could as our parents really weren't there most of the time and when they were, they'd just as well not been.

The "Behavioral Corrections" of this rule caused us to have a lot of issues with authority and to not trust adults of any gender because males and females ARE equally abusive... of all forms of abuses including sexual. We'd been told enough lies to learn to NOT listen to other peoples so called advice. We were forced under authoritarian dictatorial rule and tyranny. Even the school systems were more concerned with their AUTHORITARIANISM rather than education. They truly try to BREAK People and this is exactly what they do.

The Authoritarian system punishes people for the sake of Punishment, Establishment of Authority (on a false perception there of) and Forced Obedience to

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force one against their own will to submit to the will of another. This model uses aggression, abuse, torture, rape and murder to create FEAR and Compliance by hurting people and killing nonconformists. Instead of correcting behaviours it solidifies many "bad" behaviours and encourages others and an eventual uprising and revolt. This system breeds hatred and resistance then it creates vengeance and avengers. People, with all intent, will break the systems rules and laws in defiance and dare the oppressors and abusers to come get them. It turns into a self perpetuating out of control spiral every time and history is full of this.

The Authoritarian System is one of imposed power and is a corrupt power that will corrupt so absolutely and completely the system that uses it and abuses people with it. Most Societies today LOVE and use this system because they profit from it. Profit off the torture and abuses of others is the epitome of tyranny, corruption and the concept of evil. This sounds more like the system needs dismantled and then corrected from bottom to top so that it educates and prevents by actually actively being engaged and correcting behaviours and NOT profit from it. That would be a corrective system that keeps people engaged or that engages people in society and makes them productive ^{willful} members.

productive member of society and shows them the destruction their previous behavior caused and further causes. This is essential because the responsive and disengaged LOCK EM UP AND MAKE EM SLAVES. WE DON'T CARE WHAT HAPPENS TO EM CORRECTIONS system of today... This abusive, corrupt and manipulative as well as predatory Authoritarian system is nothing but absent and incorrect corrections.
