My freedom ended on a Thursday in September 2019. I became an inmate on that day for the Texas Dept. of Criminal Justice. The jury found it necessary to convict me of 3 charges sentencing me to 10, 20 years, and 2 life sentences with the possibility of parole after 30 years. Now, mind you I took no lives or life and I had never been in trouble besides speeding tickets as a teen, had never been inside of a jail in my 32 years of life. I was an honorable veteran of 5 years of service with tours to Korea and Iraq with multiple awards as well as citations, yet I was such an animal for a crime that because there was no evidence at all I was a mastermind at hiding my crimes so there would be no evidence to find, even though I have an average I.Q. and a high school diploma with zero collage, I am an amazing and terrifying criminal! If you can imagine it, believe it or not charges like mine happen on a daily basis with a 99.9% conviction rating especially in Texas due to tough on crime. I tell all who read this I was charged with a Sex Crime, viewed to be the worst of the worst even compared to murders. Which there are hundreds with both charges yet, many with mine, unless they signed and admitted guilt, serve outrageous amounts of time even compared to A LOT of murderers!! I, like many, others went with a jury trial, because ~~there~~ there is of course no evidence, only hearsay so of course the jury will believe my innocents ~~escape~~ especially because the story changed 5 times, there were no locations or dates that couldn't be proven false by myself and lawyer, I had multiple witnesses to prove my evidence legit yet none of it meant anything to the Jury!

Now, 4.5 years later all those who believed in me except for 3 disappeared even my own mother and father, and hardest one of all my wife and closest ~~friend~~ friend of 8 years left. Everything I was told as a friend, husband, father, and son

amounted to absolutely nothing. I found out how much I took for granted with my entire life!! I had it all, 3 kids, 3 cars, a motorcycle, a home, friends who called me brother in my MC and I was retired. Now, I live in a room with a stranger that can change at any given time and it only consists of a toilet, table, 2 shelves, and a bed. Most in the free world would say "good, you got what you deserve!" I ask, how? I fought to prove my innocents with everything I had and now I am looking into the DA who took me to trial was disbarred 2 years ago for falsifying evidence! Which the more I've been incarcerated, is a huge percentage in the so called Justice System. That is actually a non-arguable offense to get cases overturned. Many cases get a rubber stamp by the Court of Criminal Appeals denying any and all wrong doing without looking at the proof. I've learned that my good time/work time doesn't put me closer to my "Possible" parole in 2049, it doesn't account for anything! However, even with all of that the only thing thing that still gets me is people, even the correction officers believe that we get that!!

A lot of us say "if we had a video recorder, no one would believe what goes on in prison." Also, "It can happen to anyone. Unless you have money, then you're free to go." Life is too short, learn to live it as amazing as you can and learn never take it for granted. Who knows, you may end up here with me one day ~~wondering~~ wondering, "What happened!? How could I be convicted!? I didn't do anything!?" Yep! neither did I as well as many others.
