Welcome To "K.K.K." ville ... Feb. 22, 2016

I thought that there was no way that the oppression, har assment, and degradation could get any worse that Georgia State Prison, in Reids-Ville Ga; but I was wrong! When we turned onto the Street to Hays State Prison; the sign might as well read; welcome to kkkville... From the time we exited the bus; we have been threatened to be tased, beat and ultimately killed; in the lawful name of justice of the Ga. Dept. of Corrections if we violated any rules at this facility. If G.S.P. was the frying pan; then Hays is the fire. I have spent several years in G.S.P.'s Admin. Seg. unit and it was and "Supreme!" That exposed their struggle in a Bayview article in 2015. I had to personally congratulate these comrades and even sneak food to them on occasions; as well as numerous other "Torture Chamber" victims when I could.

My punishment for these endeavors? A "first class" ticket to Hays Stake Prison. Where they claim to have perfected Tier II. There is no way that this is possible having been a victim at G.S.P....

I am in General Population right now; but I know that my journey will lead me there, sooner or later. I pray that I do not find out first hand, but I am mentally, spiritually and physically prepared.

My fellow comrade and I met in 2012 in what he calls "The Belly of The Beast" at G.S.P. We challenged and fought every violation that we could think of and most recently, in November 2015; we were victims of their physical abuse; something that we had managed to avoid up until that point.

and myself were jumped on by the entire first shift. Male and females alike.

was even stomped and thrown down two (2) flights of stairs while handcuffed behind his back.

on Feb. 5th, 2016; myself, and several other Brothers of Awareness, participated in the prisons' Black History Program, that was watered by being called. Multicultural Diversity Program; but we stuck

to our own BLAP print. In fact, we convinced the prisoner's to march with their fist for peace held high. And after a speech, he had his fist raised in the air and I followed suit. And he chanted "BLAP power!" When my comrade returned to his seat, I whispered to him; "We've getting transfered for this one!" We shipped out Feb. 15th.

Coincidence that we transferred the same night, to the same prison, to the same cellblock, to the same cell?? I don't think so? They must know that we will not falter. We will not waiver. And we will not stop our stride. Because

We are the "Indomitable Bldg man ...

We were placed in the so-called . Thunder Dorm; where violence and misbehavior is prone to take place. But that's nothing new to me throughout these 71/2 years of incarceration. In fact, I welcome it, just to challenge my ability to awaken the sleeping giants. The doaf, dumb and blind. It will not be the last time this occurrs as long as I am a political prisoner combating the injustice of like-minded prisoners.

The individuals who placed us here did not know the extent of our love for our nation or the depths to which we will swim to bring our brothers' equality and peace in this corrupt system. Nothing happens with out reason. G. S.P., "Tier Hostage one", "Supreme", and many more were the awakening of my inner drive. The foundation of the Ga. Dept. of Corrections was flawed by placing Comrades and I here at Hays S.P.. It gave us our opportunity needed to spread awareness and to pull the curtains open here. If they decide to separate or move us to different facilities; we will still continue to expose the guts of this system until someone helps us like they did in Cali. Until they stop afflicting us, appressing us and degrading us of our human value.

I already see the hopeful and helpless spirits depending on us to be their leader. So, in the words of the late John F. Kennedy PAGE #2

11 If not us, who? If not now, when?" As prisoners give us the rundown about how H.S.P. is run; we're like "No way!" And they tell us to "just watch!" and we tell them; "No! You just watch what we do!"

I've already noticed the attack locations . Recreation, Education, Religious Services, Sanitation, Negligence of Staff, Verbal threats and abuse; I could go on and on Not to mention the adrenaline rush this Stone Cold Steve Austin looking Correctional Emergency Response Team (CERT) member and Sgt. exemplified when he arrived at a 10-10 (fight

Code) in the Chowhall.

Once he realized it was the wrong messhall he'd entered; he alm-6st panicked because he was missing the action. Later on; I'd heard rumor that three (3) different CERT members had Tased 1 prisoner to So-call "subdue" him. They were even heard bragging about it a few moments later. So; you see, I am forewarning Amerikkka about "Kokokoville" State plantation in Redneck, Georgia ... Whatever your choice of Salvation may be e. . Pray for us ... And to my Georgia State Prison population; Though me and BLAQman Seer may longer be there with you in the flesh, we still han live with you all in the mind and spirit. Keep Your heads up and Never Forget The Struggle . . Righteous Luv 4eva; BYEKING COE THE GREAT
