I have been in prison for over 10 years and I have never been ~~threatened~~ threatened to be sent to the "hole" for simply looking at a ~~cor~~ correctional officer, until Sunday March 18th 2020.

One of my jobs is working handing out commissary on Sunday mornings. I have had this job for over a year and I thought of it as just a typical Sunday. It was not.

At around 3:30 pm, I was sitting in my cell watching t.v. when over the prison intercom system the announcement came for me to report to the officers office and my door opened. I was a little confused on why and what I was called for.

I went to the officers office and there were 2 officers, 1 male and 1 female. The female officer named [REDACTED] said that the way I looked at her during commissary made her uncomfortable and that she can send me to "A" floor (also called the hole) for it. She said she has 5 inmates who think ~~I stated I~~ the same thing but refused to tell me who they are.

I made it clear to her I didn't look at her in any specific way. I was just doing my job at commissary as I always do.

Officer [REDACTED] said if I look at her again like I did "I will send you to "A" floor!"

I am now walking on egg shells with a floor officer who has been looking for a way to send me to the SHU. Her inmate minions want her to. I guess I will just have to wait and see.

What ~~kind~~ is the world coming to where you can be put in the "hole" or "A" floor just because someone doesn't like the way you supposedly looked at them?

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
