There HAS BEEN A BELIEF in prison that snitches ARE the scum OF the earth. That the break in trust and loyalty among the untrustworthy and Disloyal is AN UNFORGIVABLE ACT. We can go on and on ABOUT the warped belief that so many say they Follow. Yet, the reality OF THE ACT couldn't be Further From the truth.

This topic can take many directions, but today the Focus is within these silent wars.

Openly, Reporting wrongs, snitching, telling, Singing, Stool pigeons is chastised to the point OF death. But the reality is so much more than the outspoken belief.

Today, in prison, you have more informants than reportable acts. It extends From your cellmate reporting you For HAVING an EXTRA pair OF SHOES TO Shot-callers giving up the dopeman because he simply doesn't like you. Prison OFFICIALS want you to sing, expect you to sing, and when you're done, tell us you sang.

The profound reality is THAT OFFICIALS would be clueless to misconduct, drugs, and violence without informants. OR A lucky FLUXE. On their own, they would be lost. At the very same time, the snitches are not some random inmate who overheard a conversation OR witnessed a transaction. Never. It's AN individual who is in debt and doesn't want to pay, an individual who is upset he's not the one making money, OR A guy who pretends to be involved to give you up For no reason, no gain, no benefit.

You have inmates being sent to the Hole because the prison was informed by anonymous paper dropped in the mail box that they planned to escape, OR the dopeman owed thousands being turned in to OFFICIALS by use OF AN ANONYMOUS paper dropped in the mail box that he planned to stab an OFFICER, OR inmates accused OF ATTEMPTED rape by anonymous paper being placed in the mail box. ALL OF THEM, just to be taken OFF the yard.

Lets not Forget the inmates who openly tell on you, no secret notes, no shame, and no consequences. It happens so much it becomes the normal thing. Snitches don't get stitches.

Consider these scenarios and the reality of what officials are doing on their own. Nothing. They don't have to because they know that at some point, some one will tell, the officials will act on it, report they had a hunch and the circle continues. While the inmates chatter about some scumbag who snitched on the homie when it's usually the one saying it that participated in dropping the anonymous note.

That's prison today. We talk a good one and walk a bad one.
